



PARTICIPATION IN CROATIA



Since 2000 and EU Preaccession period

- Introduction of participation into local development planning – still dominant top-down
- Humanitarian aid projects and EU funded institution building projects support participatory approaches incl. civil society – contributing to institutionalisation of participatory methods

• 2013 – onwards – EU member state

- Stakeholder consultations in strategic planning on all governance levels – expert driven
- **E-consultations** platform for all legislative and strategic documents targeting broader population
- Project driven attempts to introduce democratic, social and institutional innovations – participatory budgeting, citizens assemblies …

Example of participatory budgeting in Zagreb, Croatia

- Participatory budgeting in Zagreb pilot project initiated in 2024 in 4 city districts
- Citizens have a direct influence on the decisionmaking on the spending of part of the public funds allocated by the city budget
- They identify challenges in their neighbourhoods, propose project solutions, and participate in the selection of projects to be financed through the voting process.

Piloting proces:

Proposal submission and voting system, funding of 16 selected neighbourhood projects through Communal Action Plans for 2025

City district – Podsused-Vrapce (44,910 inhabitants)

- design of the skate park - 100,000 EUR

City district – Peščenica-Žitnjak (53,023 inhabitants)

- arrangement of the driveway of Augusta Cesarca Primary School EUR 40,000
- expansion of the children's playground in Volovcica EUR 30,000
- landscaping of the Little Prince park EUR 30,000

City district – Trnje (40,539 inhabitants)

- installation of equipment for children in "motorcycle park" Vrbik EUR 30,000
- planting trees in the yard of G. Vitez Elementary School EUR 10,000
- renovation of benches at the G. Vitez elementary school playground EUR 20,000

City district - Tresnjevka – south (65,324 inhabitants)

- Preparation of project documentation:
 - arrangement of the pedestrian path and installation of a bench 4,000 EUR
 - construction of paths on the southeastern part of Hrgovici and Horvacanska streets EUR 5,000
 - reconstruction of the playground at the Srednjaci Kindergarten EUR 4,000,
 - construction of a tartan track in the park of Emil Cossett EUR 10,000
 - drawing a NO STOP zone at Palinovecka street and Kutnjacki put street 10,000 EUR
- installation of a fence around the children's playground EUR 6,000
- installation of bollards around the pedestrian crossing at the intersection of Slavenski Street and Jarnoviceva Street - EUR 30,000

- installation of 20 benches along the sidewalk from Gredic to the "Stjepan Radic" Student Dormitory - EUR 20,000.
