THE ARTICLES OF NON-PROFIT ASSOCIATION

European Local Development Network Association MTÜ

(hereinafter the Association)

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1. The Association is a non-profit voluntary association of individuals and legal persons.
- 2. The name of the Association is **European Local Development Network Association MTÜ**.
- 3. The Association operates under the Non-profit Associations Act of the Republic of Estonia and these Articles of Association.
- 4. The Association is established for an indefinite period.
- 5. The registered office of the Association is Pepleri 6, Tartu 51003, Estonia.
- 6. The financial year of the Association is from 1 January to 31 December.

II. OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

- 1. The main objective of the Association is to promote community-led local development (CLLD) in Europe.
- 2. To achieve its objectives, the Association may:
 - a. organise events, workshops, and seminars;
 - b. participate in international cooperation projects;
 - c. gather and share knowledge and good practices;
 - d. carry out policy advocacy and strategic initiatives;
 - e. publish materials and operate communication platforms;
 - f. apply for and manage funding and resources;
 - g. perform other lawful activities aligned with its mission.

III. MEMBERSHIP

- 1. Membership in the Association is voluntary. Any natural or legal person who supports the objectives of the Association and complies with its statutes may become a member.
- 2. The Association may have the following categories of members:
 - a. Individual members natural persons;
 - b. Partner organisations legal entities sharing the Association's aims.
- 3. All members have equal rights unless otherwise provided by law or these Articles.
- 4. A person or organisation wishing to become a member shall submit an application.
- 5. Admission and removal of members shall be decided by the Management Board.
- 6. A member may withdraw at any time by written notice.
- 7. The Management Board may exclude a member if:

- a. they violate the Articles or decisions of the governing bodies;
- b. they damage the Association's reputation;
- c. they fail to fulfil obligations, including payment of fees.
- 8. The excluded member may request the General Meeting to review the decision.
- 9. The Management Board maintains a register of members.

IV. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF MEMBERS

- 1. Members have the right to:
 - a. participate in the activities and decision-making of the Association;
 - b. vote at the General Meeting;
 - c. be elected to the governing bodies;
 - d. receive information about the work and finances of the Association;
 - e. submit suggestions and proposals.
- 2. Members are obliged to:
 - a. follow the Articles and decisions of the General Meeting and Management Board;
 - b. pay membership fees if applicable;
 - c. act in line with the purpose of the Association and support its development.
- 3. The General Meeting shall decide whether a membership fee is applied and in what amount.

V. GENERAL MEETING

- 1. The General Meeting is the highest governing body of the Association.
- 2. The General Meeting shall be held at least once a year.
- 3. An extraordinary General Meeting shall be convened by the Management Board or at the written request of at least one-tenth of the members.
- 4. Members shall be notified of the General Meeting **at least two weeks in advance in a reproducible form** (e.g. by email).
- 5. The General Meeting has a quorum if at least **25% of members** are present or represented.
- 6. If the quorum is not met, a new meeting shall be convened within three weeks to three months, which is competent to adopt decisions regardless of the number of members present.
- 7. A member may participate by written proxy.
- 8. Decisions are made by a simple majority unless otherwise required by law or these Articles.
- 9. Amendments to the Articles or dissolution of the Association require a **two-thirds majority** of members present.

VI. MANAGEMENT BOARD

- 1. The Management Board shall direct and represent the Association.
- 2. The Board consists of **2 to 12 members**, elected by the General Meeting for a term of **two years**.
- 3. Board members may be re-elected.
- 4. The General Meeting may remove a Board member at any time.
- 5. The Board elects a Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer from among its members.
- 6. The Board meets at least once every two months and may meet virtually.
- 7. Each Board member has individual representation rights unless otherwise decided by the General Meeting.
- 8. The Board may form working groups or a coordination team as necessary.

VII. SUPERVISION

- 1. The General Meeting may appoint an **auditor or controller** to supervise the Association's finances.
- 2. The auditor may not be a member of the Management Board or the Association's accountant.
- 3. The auditor shall have access to all necessary information and documents.

VIII. FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

- 1. The assets of the Association consist of:
 - a. membership fees;
 - b. donations, grants, and sponsorship;
 - c. income from training, publications, and services;
 - d. project-based funding and other legal sources.
- 2. The funds of the Association may be used only for achieving its objectives.
- 3. The Management Board ensures proper accounting in accordance with the **Accounting Act of the Republic of Estonia**.
- 4. The annual report is prepared by the Board, approved by the General Meeting, and submitted to the **Business Register**.

IX. MERGER, DIVISION AND DISSOLUTION

- 1. The Association may be merged, divided or dissolved by a decision of the General Meeting or in accordance with the law.
- 2. Upon dissolution, after satisfying creditors' claims, the remaining assets shall be transferred:
 - a. to a non-profit organisation with similar aims that benefits from income tax incentives; or
 - b. to a public legal entity (such as the state or local government), in accordance with **§ 50(1) of the Non-profit Associations Act**.
